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#### <u>Please read the additional information below carefully and initial each line if you and your student</u> <u>understand and agree.</u>

### *If your child is selected for a part in the production, the following are expected from you and him/her.*

- 1. Your student must attend all rehearsals required throughout the week from after school into the evening, Monday to Thursday (about 4.5 hours), depending on his/her role. He/she must keep the week completely free from any after school activities, lessons, games, practices, and appointments. If he/she will have to miss a rehearsal, the MCT team may give away his/her part to another student.
- 2. Childcare is not available after audition. Your student must be picked up promptly by 5:45 pm, but he/she may be asked to stay for the first rehearsal until 8:15 pm. Please bring a sack dinner, just in case. He/she will only be released to you unless we are notified otherwise.
- 3. A program fee of \$40/child, max of \$100 per family, is due as soon as the cast members are announced.
- 4. Your student must be available for the dress rehearsal at 9:10 am, the afternoon (1:45 pm) and evening (6:30 pm) performances, on Friday, October 20, 2017. He/she will be excused from all classes that day.
- 5. Participating in MCT is a privilege. Respectful, kind, and polite behavior, as well as following directions from all adults, is required. If your student chooses not to act in this manner, he/she may be removed from the program.
- 6. Your student is expected to work on a quiet project while not rehearsing homework, reading, and coloring, are all good choices. Running and horseplay are not allowed.

# If your child is not selected for a part:

- 7. He/she will be automatically included to attend the enrichment workshop in one of the following sessions (please check the session that would fit best for your child's grade and schedule):
  - a. Acting K-2, Tuesday, October 17, 8:15-9:00 am, Apollo MPR
  - b. Acting K-2, Wednesday, October 18, 8:15-9:00 am, Apollo MPR
  - c. **Improv** 3-5, Thursday, October 19, 8:15-9:00 am, Apollo MPR
- 8. This is not required but would be another opportunity to have a theater experience. If you wish for your child to not participate in the workshop, please let us know so we can give the spot to another student.
- 9. Bus transport is not provided. Please arrange for another mode of transportation to get your child to school.
