• All acts must be well prepared: full costumes, props, music in CD format (please test it in advance on a <u>cd player</u> ,
not a computer, we will not have a dock for mp3 versions of songs)
• Two minutes or less (please have your music cut in advance)
• If you wish to sing: You may only use a karaoke version of the song. We want to hear your voice, not someone
else's.
• No lip sync acts will be permitted.
• No vulgar, violent, crude, or suggestive lyrics or dance moves will be permitted. Keep in mind your act needs to be appropriate for an audience of 5 to 11 year olds.
• Outfits and costumes must fall within school guidelines.
• All songs need to have a <u>printed version</u> of the lyrics attached to permission slip. This will be a fast way to help weed out any inappropriate content of songs.
• All acts that meet the guidelines and are well prepared will make it into the show.
• NEW THIS YEAR: Permission form signed and <u>turned in by Friday February 27<sup>th</sup></u> . Please do not show up
at auditions with a permission form.
